Our Dwelling Place Psalm 90

1. Read Psalm 90 again. What stands out to you? What do you wonder about?
2. Have you ever experienced reading Scripture to be like entering a “literary temple”? How do you encounter God?
3. In following the example of this prayer of Moses, what can you **declare** about God? What difference does it make that he is the everlasting God? What words of gratitude can you offer?
4. What do you need to **confess**? What part of yourself do you bring to God today? Do you feel like “new grass” or “dry and withered”?
5. What do you want to **lament**? What parts of life are difficult to bear right now? Do you ever feel like God is pouring out his wrath or hiding his face from you?
6. What do you want to **ask** God? Where do you need his wisdom and mercy? What are you longing for? How might your life be different if you started each day satisfied in the love of God?
7. What do you need to accept from God? What would it look like to **rest** in the God who is your dwelling place? What would it look like to trust him to establish the work of your hands?
8. How can we pray for you?
